



Leo Club Program 50th Anniversary **Ways to Celebrate**

1. Organize an international banquet including food and drink from some of the 134 countries where the Leo program exists.
2. Create a Leo club display in your school, college or community so that you can promote the Leo club, its history and the club's upcoming events.
3. Organize a 'birthday party' for Leo clubs with cake and balloons, invite children who are in need to celebrate the milestone with you.
4. Contact your local newspaper or radio station and suggest a feature in the local news about your Leo club and the Leo Club Program's contribution around the world.
5. Donate a needed item to a local school, hospital, park or community center, such as a park bench, that includes a plaque with your Leo club name engraved on it.
6. Put together a time capsule, including memorabilia from your club's activities and members as well as some information about the history of the Leo Club Program. Bury the time capsule and leave instructions for future club members, to dig out after a certain number of years.
7. Hold a t-shirt or poster design contest with the theme "Celebrating 50 Years of Leo Service."
8. Include a 50th anniversary celebration at the Leo district and multiple district conferences.
9. Come to the Leo Global Conference held in conjunction with the Lions 90th International Convention, to celebrate with Leos from around the world.
10. Sponsor a Leo 50th anniversary sporting event, such as a cricket or baseball tournament, or another activity that brings your community together.
11. Hold a 50-hour service marathon. Invite Leos, Lions and their families to volunteer throughout the 50-hour period.
