PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Naresh Aggarwal, of Delhi, India, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of the International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 81st International Convention, held in Birmingham, England, June 29-July 3, 1998.

Past Director Aggarwal is an industrial businessman.
