John O. Gregory, of Manassas, Virginia, USA, served a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 60th International Convention, held June 29-July 2, 1977 in New Orleans, Louisiana, USA.

Past Director Gregory is the president of a construction company.
