PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Luis Murad, of Pilar, Argentina, served a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs after his election at the association's 63rd convention held in Chicago, Illinois, USA, in July 1980.

Past Director Murad is an odontologist and specializes in buccomaxillofacial surgery. He is also a professor at the University of Buenos Aires and an official speaker for the Odontological Association of Argentina and the Argentinean Association of Buccomaxillofacial Surgery. He is currently the chairman of the board of directors for Integral Medical Treatment S.A., a pre-paid medical plan company.

A Lion since 1961, Past Director Murad has held every office in his district and in the Fatima Pilar Club. He has also held the offices of district governor and council chairman. He served as the editor of the Argentina edition of THE LION Magazine for seven years and has published eight books and 284 articles on Lion subjects.

For his efforts on behalf of the association, Past Director Murad has received the 100% District Governor Award, an Extension Award, a Membership Development Award, 13 International President's Awards and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor the association can bestow upon a member. He is also a Melvin Jones Fellow.

In addition to his Lions activities, for 12 years Past Director Murad has been the president of the Pilar Athletic Club. He has also served as Mayor of the city of Pilar.
