

GIOVANNI RIGONE
PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Giovanni Rigone, of Pavia, Italy, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 71st International Convention, held in Denver, Colorado, USA, June 29-July 2, 1988.

Past Director Rigone, a doctor of engineering, is the owner of an engineering firm and president of the Pavia College of Engineers and Architects. From July 1993 until October 1995 he served as the Deputy Mayor of Pavia.

A member of the Pavia Host Lions Club since 1969, Past Director Rigone has held many positions within the association, including club president, district governor and council chairman.
