PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Kazuo Shigetomi, of Sapporo, Japan, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 69th International Convention, held in New Orleans, Louisiana, USA, July 8-12, 1986.
