

DR. YO CHUL SHIN
PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Dr. Yo Chul Shin, of Seoul, Republic of Korea, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 69th International Convention, held in New Orleans, Louisiana, USA, July 9-12, 1986.

Past Director Shin is a surgeon and clinical professor at two medical universities.
