

HANS HERMANN STURM
PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Hans Hermann Sturm, of Düsseldorf, Germany, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 61st International Convention, held in Tokyo, Japan, June 21-24, 1978.

Past Director Sturm, personal managing director of the largest European paper and board manufacturer, now retired, has served the association in many positions, including club secretary, club president, vice governor, district governor and as chairman of the European Youth Committee.

In recognition of his active participation on behalf of the association, Past Director Sturm has received 11 International President's Awards and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor bestowed upon a member by the association. In addition, Lion Sturm is a Melvin Jones Fellow since 1977, a member of Lions Clubs International Foundation, the Million Member Club and is also a Life Member. He was the chairman of LCIF-Germany for ten years and the chairman of "Gesellschaft der Freunde Lions e.V" (a financing institution) and the association's liaison officer to UNESCO. He is an honorary member of Lions Club Düsseldorf-Rhenania.

Past Director Sturm was active on several paper industry boards in his country and abroad. He is a member of the Board of CARE-Deutschland e.V.(NGO).
