SPOTLIGHT ON CHILDREN projects provide Leos with the opportunity to enrich the lives of children in adverse circumstances in countless ways, including:

- Collecting food and clothes for children in need.
- Repairing a playground.
- Implementing an after-school tutoring program.
- Visiting children in a hospital.
- Fundraising for immunization programs.



Leos provide hope when they implement projects to help **CHILDREN** in need.

IN INDIA, Leos assist children with disabilities by organizing a sports competition where the children can showcase their abilities.

IN PORTUGAL, Leos provide educational experiences for underprivileged children through outings to museums, workplaces and other sites that stimulate the children's learning.

IN TUNISIA, Leos spend time in a local hospital with young patients. They take the children to the zoo, beach, and have set up a special room in the hospital where the children can play, listen to music and use computers.

IN THE USA, Leos paste materials in picture books so visually impaired children can develop tactile skills needed to learn braille.
