



## ***APPLICATION PROCESS FOR LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT***

The application should be given to Lions who meet the qualifications listed below. The person interviewing the candidate for leadership development chairperson should be knowledgeable of the qualifications.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

**The multiple/single district leadership development chairperson must possess the ability and skills to identify, develop and present leadership development programs that meet the needs of the Lions of multiple/single districts.**

1. The Leadership Committee recommends that the appointed multiple district leadership development chairperson will have served as a minimum of district governor before being appointed chairperson in order to effectively train the district governors-elect.
2. A proven track record in leadership development or similar work, such as training, education and event planning.
3. A fundamental understanding of adult learning characteristics, effective teamwork and communications, teambuilding and member motivation.
4. A knowledge or strong willingness to seek out innovative training techniques, curriculum content and materials.
5. Credibility with other Lions.
6. Effective presentation skills (i.e., public speaking, workshop presenter, etc)
7. Time available to commit to a three-year term and accept no other position in the association that would conflict with time and energy needed for this position.
8. Ability to travel within the multiple district.
9. Ability to attend a leadership seminar sponsored by the association.
