Change Leadership – Openness to change is a must.; This means taking initiative, taking risks, being open to diverse opinions and to encourage creativity and innovation.

Conflict Resolution – Learn how to define and identify sources of conflict, become aware of their personal conflict resolution style and apply strategies for resolving conflict.

Creativity – Be able to encourage creativity in meetings and projects within your clubs. This will help stimulate current membership and attract new members.

Diversity – Understand the dimensions of diversity and the difference between assimilation and pluralism, and recognize the benefits to clubs and districts.

Mentoring – You will learn the concept and benefits of mentoring; building a foundation of effective mentoring relationships; actually plan a mentoring session.

Project Management – Learn to discuss various strategies for project management, develop a game plan, implement project monitoring and reviewing techniques and champion continuous project improvement.

Presentation Skills – Increase your public speaking skills; learn how to prepare a speech outline, and sharpen your interview techniques.

Sharing Best Practices – Share the best practices of your club, exchange your ideas with other Lions in the areas of service projects, membership recruitment, training suggestions, retention ideas, new club development ideas, etc...
