



## Assignment 2: Motivating Your Team

### Overview

Motivation is the key to great achievements in your district. Motivation is created by meeting the individual needs that drive Lions to take action and achieve results. Knowing these needs is essential to getting your team to put forth their best efforts to accomplish goals. As district governor, you will have opportunities to help other Lions perform the duties of their respective positions, as well as achieve their own personal goals.

The purpose of this assignment is to prepare you to motivate Lions on your team. Once you recognize and understand the various individual motivation factors, you will develop a plan to motivate your team members and other Lions in your district.

### Objectives

After completing this assignment, vice district governors will be able to:

- Define the concept of motivation
- Apply appropriate motivation strategies based on individual needs
- Motivate the district team and other Lions in the district

### Assignment

This assignment requires that you 1.) view the DVD - Motivating Your Team, 2.) complete the Lions Learning Center course on Member Motivation and 3.) develop a plan to motivate Lions in your district.

To begin the course, go to the Lions Clubs International website, [www.lionsclubs.org](http://www.lionsclubs.org), and search for “Lions Learning Center”. This will take you to the Lions Learning Center page. Scroll down and click on “Member Motivation” course. After completing the online course, consider the following questions and develop a plan to increase motivation in your district:

- Do you know which motivation factors will motivate each of your team members?

- How will you encourage them to motivate other Lions, such as club officers?
