

**DR. NELSON VIDAL
INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

Dr. Nelson Vidal from Lima, Peru, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 90th International Convention, held in Chicago, Illinois, USA, July 2-6, 2007.

Director Vidal is a surgeon.
