



Rules for 2009 LION Magazine Photo Contest

1. Eligibility/Exclusions

Photos submitted must be taken by a Lion or Leo. Employees of Lions Clubs International and Lions Clubs International Foundation and their families are excluded. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.

2. Entry Instructions

- To enter into the contest, eligible contestants must submit photos to LION Magazine, 300 W. 22nd Street, Oak Brook, IL 60523-8842, United States. Mail the color prints or disk with images to LION Magazine, 300 W. 22nd St., Oak Brook, IL, 60523-8842, United States. (Do not write on the front or back of a photo.) Digital images also can be uploaded to <http://portal.lionsclubs.org/publicrelations> (click on Proceed to Upload, click on Upload Files, click on Browse, go to your file with the photo and click on it, click open and click on Upload). If you upload the image, send an e-mail to jay.copp@lionsclubs.org to let the LION know the name of the photo, the photographer's name, address, phone number, club name, date of the photographed event and a brief description of the event.
- Mailed entries must be postmarked by June 10, 2010 and uploaded entries must be sent by June 10, 2010. All entries must include the photographer's name, address, phone number and Lion/Leo club name, date of photographed event and brief description of the event. Contestants must not write on the back or front of a photo.

3. Photos submitted

Photos must be of a Lions service project or fundraiser that takes place between May 1, 2009, and May 31, 2010. More than one photo may be submitted and different photos may be submitted at different times. Digital images must have a resolution of 300 dpi or higher.

4. Winner Selection & Notification

Winners will be selected and notified by LION Magazine staff. Contestants agree to publication and/or display of their names and likenesses to be made at the discretion of Lions Clubs International.

5. Waiver

As a condition of entering this contest, entrant agrees that: (1) under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for any losses or damages, and participant hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and waives any and all rights to have
