



## Rules for the 2002-2003 100% District Governor Award

### A. **Mandatory Requirements**

1. Promote the International Program throughout the year.
2. Achieve membership net gain in the district (deaths and transfers not counted), or sponsor one new club.
3. See to it that each Lions club in the district submit monthly Membership Report (C-23-A) to meet the following due dates:
  - 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month – Clubs in USA
  - 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month – Clubs in Canada
  - 20<sup>th</sup> of the following month – Clubs elsewhere

In any given month, up to 10 percent of delinquency is permitted. Any two months may be excluded from this requirement. In all cases where reports are delinquent, the district governor shall inform International Headquarters as to what action he/she took to obtain the missing reports.

4. See to it that all clubs in the district submit Club Officers Report (PU-101) to reach International Headquarters by May 31. Up to 10 percent of delinquency is permitted.
5. See to it that all clubs in the district submit Annual Activities Report (A-1) to reach International Headquarters by June 30. Up to 10 percent of delinquency is permitted.
6. Hold club officers' school with all club officers invited.
7. Visit all the clubs in the district (Can be substituted by vice district governor or governor's representative)

### B. **Elective Requirements**

1. Extension (Achieve two):
  - One New Century Lions Club
  - Two Club Branches
  - One University Club
  - Conversion of a Lioness Club to Lions Club
  - One speciality club (e.g. special interest club, ethnic club)
2. Retention (Achieve one):
  - Reactivation of a club(s) placed on status quo during the previous year.
  - 50 percent of clubs in the district qualify for Club Retention Award.
  - District reports fewer total drops than previous year.
3. LCIF (Achieve one):
  - Have at least three new Melvin Jones Fellows in the district.
  - Secure 5% gain in total contribution as compared to the previous year.
  - Obtain the equivalent of US\$100 donation per club in the district.

No request for review of award eligibility shall be considered unless received at international headquarters within 12 months after completion of governor's term of office.
