

Build your own club goals

- ► Select 2 or 3 things to accomplish
 - ► 3 Membership goals
 - ► 3 Service goals
 - ► 3 Fundraising ideas



Develop the Plan

- ► Using smart goals, develop your club plan
- ► Specify who is going to do what
- **▶** Get Lions excited around this process
- ► Make challenging goals but not overly challen



GMA Light for small club

- Apply the concept of how you run a small business
- Build an action plan
- ► Follow the goals



Let's grow our Service and Membership

- **► Club self-analysis**
 - ► What we do well in our club?
 - What we do not so well?
 - What can we do better?
 - **▶** Where do we see opportunities?



Decide what first three goals to tackle

- ► Set three (3) goals for quick success
 - ► What will be done?
 - ► Who will do it?
 - ► When will it be done?
- ► How do we get there?
 - ► Write down steps necessary to achieve goals.
 - ► Use Smart Goals as a guide
 - Measure results
 - Adjust as needed

Roles of a Zone Chair

- Serve as a link between the Lions Clubs and the District Cabinet
- 2. Key member of the Global Action Team at the District level
- 3. Set goals and make action plans for your year as Zone Chair and submit to DG
- 4. Serve as a member of the District Governor's Advisory Committee



Responsibilities of a Zone Chair

- 1. Hold 4 Zone Meetings in the fiscal year
- 2. Make a report of the meetings and forward to District Governor and to Lions Club International
- 3. Visit each club in the Zone at least once per year
- 4. Promote Global Membership Approach for Clubs and Club Quality Initiative



Reasons for Club Visits

- 1. Represent the Lions Clubs at at District Cabinet Meetings
- 2. A personal visit is better than a virtual meeting
- 3. Function as the eyes and ears of the District Governor
- 4 Serve as a resource for the Clubs and its officers
- 5. Assist Clubs to reach their goals and the officers to be successful




