Actions for Success	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Collaborates with your Global Action Team Constitutional Area Leaders and your GLT and GST vice constitutional area leaders to further initiatives focused on leadership development, membership growth and expanding humanitarian service.• Participates in area leadership forum and collaborates with the constitutional area's Global Action Team to conduct relevant seminars, events, and projects.• Shares successes, opportunities and needs with the GMT constitutional area leader and LCI staff.• Ensures that area leaders submit development plans.• Monitors area leaders' progress reporting related to the development plan and ensures timely submission to constitutional area leaders before the scheduled board of director's meeting.• Conducts quarterly email communications and/or phone calls with area leaders to track successes and identify needs/issues.• Provide ongoing support and guidance to the area leaders.• Create and distribute relevant information to area leaders.• Encourages leaders to include diverse populations in Global Action Team initiatives.
Measuring Success	At the end of each fiscal year, increase total membership by: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Decrease membership drops by a minimum of 5%.• Increasing women's membership in support of LCI's 50-50 parity goal.
