**PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

Joseph J. Camarda of Leicester, Massachusetts, USA, served a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs following his election at the association's 65th International Convention, held in Atlanta, Georgia, USA, June 30-July 3, 1982.
