

DR. BUD DANYLCHUK
PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Dr. Bohdan “Bud” Danylchuk, of Fort Frances, Ontario, Canada, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association’s 61st Convention held in Tokyo, Japan, June 21-24, 1978.

Past Director Danylchuk has held many offices within the association, including district governor, chairperson of the Council of Governors and co-founder of the Lions Canadian Eye Bank for District 5M. As district governor, he had the largest net membership gain in North America of 417 members. He has had 21 years of perfect attendance.

In recognition of his service to the association Past Director Danylchuk has received numerous awards, including nine District Governor Extension Awards, the 100% District Governor Award, five International President’s Awards and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor the association bestows upon its members. He is also a Melvin Jones Fellow.
