

**IL YUN KIM**  
**PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

Il Yun Kim, of Seoul, Republic of Korea, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of the International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 81st International Convention, held in Birmingham, England, June 29-July 3, 1998.

Past Director Kim serves as president of the Korea Lions Parliamentarians' League.

A member of the Seoul Dae Sung Lions Club, Past Director Kim has been a Lion since 1976. He has held many offices within the association, including club president, region chairman, district governor, district auditor and council chairman. In addition, Past Director Kim organized the Moscow Lions Club, the first Lions club in Russia.

In recognition of his service to the association, he has received numerous awards, including an extension award, three International President's Awards, a Medal of Distinction and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor the association grants its members. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

In addition to his Lion activities, Past Director Kim founded and was president of Kyongju University. He has served as a member of the Korea Committee for UNESCO and is the president of the Korean-Brazilian Parliamentarians Friendship Association. He has also served as the Construction and Transportation Committee Chairman of the Korean National Assembly.
