PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Dr. Domenico Messina from Trapani, Italy, was appointed to serve as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's board meeting held in Sydney, Australia, in July 2010.

Past Director Messina is a doctor of anatomic pathology and oncology and chief of the Anatomic Pathology Department at Hospital of Trapani.
