

JOHN B. STUART
PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

John B. "Jack" Stuart, of Jacksonville, Florida, USA, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 80th International Convention, held in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, USA, June 30-July 5, 1997.

Past Director Stuart is the president and owner of Stuarts Computing Company.

A member of the Jacksonville-Riverside Lions Club, Past Director Stuart has been a Lion since 1970. He has held many offices within the association, including club president, zone chairman, district governor and cabinet treasurer. He also served as president of the North Florida Lions Eye Bank, director of the Florida Lions Foundation for the Blind and director of the Florida Lions Camp for the Visually Handicapped.

In recognition of his service to the association, Past Director Stuart has received numerous awards, including the 100% Club President Award, the 100% District Governor Award, a Guiding Lion Award, a Rebuilding Lion Award, two Extension Awards, an International President's Leadership Award, three International President's Certificates of Appreciation, two International President's Awards and an Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor granted by the association to its members. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow and was named Lion of the Year six times by his club.

In addition to his Lion activities, Past Director Stuart is president of the Retired Association Florida Air National Guard, membership chairman for the EDEN Group (Economic Development and Enhancement of North Jacksonville) and chairman of the Sheriff's Citizen Advisory Committee. He was also vice president of the Air National Guard NCO Academy and has received the Air National Guard Meritorious Service Award and the Air National Guard Minuteman Award.

Past Director Stuart and his wife, Barbara, also a Lion, have two children, five grandchildren and one great-grandson.
