	Complete either the Zone Chairperson Training or the Certified Guiding Lion Training.			
	Host a successful Zone Meeting. Attached a copy of the agenda and minutes.

	Ensure that all clubs are in active status and each club properly elected and reported their club officers.			
	A minimum of 35% of the clubs qualified for the Club Excellence Award. The award application can be
