Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) was founded in 1968 to take the work of Lions Clubs International to new heights by tackling global problems, as well as assisting Lions with large-scale local humanitarian projects. LCIF's history is filled with high-impact projects, meaningful partnerships, and the kindness and efforts of Lions.

For the past century, Lions united to serve the needs of their communities. Our mission is so compelling, and so vital, that we became the largest service organization in the world, helping people in more than 200 countries and geographic areas. Our global footprint and grassroots approach enable us to take on local challenges efficiently and effectively. Our vast resources, including the funding and expertise of our global foundation, empower us to effect change on a global scale.

- **Saving sight through 9.7 million** cataract surgeries
- Empowering youth in more than **110 countries** through **Lions Quest**, a social and emotional learning program
- **Providing hope through US \$140 million** in disaster relief grants
- **Combating measles through immunizing more than 100 million** children

We are also scaling up our service and impact by offering innovative new opportunities to empower Lions service.
