Participate in the UN Environment
Programme's (UNEP) **Act Now: Speak Up!** initiative and voice your support for net-zero emissions.



Participate in an International Day inspiring individuals to Learn, Share and Act. There are International Days promoting clean air, preservation of the ozone layer and biological diversity.



Schedule a time for members of your club to meet with representatives of your local government. Share your concerns about local environmental challenges, and what the community can do to address them.



Explore educational opportunities designed to help young leaders build a sustainable future through UNEP Youth, Education and Environment resources.



Learn how Lions clubs around the world are advocating by viewing the **Advocacy: A New Way to Serve video** at your next club meeting. Discuss ways your club can advocate for the environment through environment community awareness and education, legislation and public policy or events and partnerships.



Challenge all Lions and Leos in your club to add at least one green habit to their daily lives. Inspire others by sharing your actions on social media. Habits might include using a reusable water bottle or coffee mug, changing to energy-saving lightbulbs or setting a time limit for your shower to reduce water consumption.



Plan a club service activity in honor of World Environment Day on June 5.
Use the posters, photos, videos and other assets provided by UNEP to raise awareness of the day in your community. Share your impact on social media using the #WorldEnvironmentDay hashtag.



Organize an **environmental teach-in** at a local school, library, house of worship, community center or park in honor of World Earth Day on April 22. Use the **Teach in Toolkit** located at earthday.org to get started.
