Prepare for your role as an officer.

Lions Clubs International offers training for the following officers:

Club Officer Training: Online training options are available for club president, secretary and treasurer.

The **Zone Chairperson Workshop** is designed to enhance the skill development of zone chairpersons.

The <u>Second Vice District Governor (SVDG) Training Program</u> is a blended learning program designed to meet the development and training needs of the second vice district governor.

The <u>First Vice District Governors/District Governors-Elect (FVDGs/DGEs) Training Program</u> is an intensive year-long program designed to equip FVDGs/DGEs with the knowledge, vision, and skills necessary to strengthen and build Lions Clubs International.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTES

Attend an institute.

As Lions and Leos continue to seek out opportunities to Learn, Lead and Grow, in-person **Leadership Development Institutes** are available to support them in achieving their goals throughout their leadership journey.

Develop skills to become an effective leader.

The <u>Emerging Lions Leadership Institute</u> (<u>ELLI)</u> prepares Lions and Leos for leadership positions at the at the club level.

The <u>Regional Lions Leadership Institute</u> (<u>RLLI</u>) prepares Lions and Leos for leadership positions throughout the association and may be customized to accommodate the needs of each area.

The <u>Advanced Lions Leadership Institute</u> (<u>ALLI</u>) focuses on developing the leadership skills of Lions and Leos with a desire to at the zone, region and district levels.

Help train the next generation of leaders.

The <u>Faculty Development Institute (FDI)</u> is provides Lions and Leos with foundational knowledge and skills to train at the club, district and multiple district level. The curriculum focuses on training delivery and techniques to facilitate in-person instruction.

The Lions Certified Instructor Program (LCIP) provides training and certifies Lions who wish to serve as faculty at the International level, including the FVDG/DGE Seminar. The curriculum is designed to enhance existing knowledge and optimize skills for adult learning.

Invest in future leaders.

The Leadership Development <u>International Institute Program</u> provides in-person learning, offered at the constitutional area level.

The Leadership Development <u>Local Institute Program</u> provides options for local leaders to manage and tailor training in multiple districts, districts and/or undistricted areas.

The Leadership Development Institute Grant Program Program offers funds towards conducting a local Emerging Lions Leadership Institute (ELLI) or Regional Lions Leadership Institute (RLLI).

The Leadership Development <u>Multiple District Grant Program</u> offers funds to support First and Second Vice District Governor Training.

The Leadership Development <u>District Grant Program</u> offers funds to support the Zone Chairperson Workshop.
