Purpose of Lions Certified Instructor Program (LCIP)

To provide consistent delivery of effective training at all levels by increasing the number of qualified instructors, while providing a framework for broadening and deepening the knowledge and experience of instructors.

Pursuing LCIP Certification through Observation (without attending training)

Lions who have served as Group Leader at the International First Vice District Governors/District Governors-Elect (FVDG/DGE) Seminar or faculty at a Lions Clubs International-directed institute from July 2012 to the present can request to be observed and evaluated for LCIP certification.

Observation can occur when serving as Group Leader at the International FVDG/DGE Seminar or faculty at a Lions International-directed institute.

If not invited to be a FVDG/DGE Group Leader or Lions International-directed institute faculty in the near future, a qualifying Lion may request to be observed serving as faculty at a Lions training event (see more information under "Observation Process").

Observation Eligibility Requirements

Applications to pursue LCIP certification through observation (without attending LCIP training) will be accepted only from Lions who have served as FVDG/DGE Seminar Group Leader or Lions International-directed institute faculty <u>from</u> July 2012 to the present.

This application is a request for <u>observation only</u>. Lions who have training experience but have not served as FVDG/DGE Seminar Group Leader or Lions Clubs International-directed institute faculty should determine if they are eligible to pursue LCIP certification through training. Visit the resource section on the website to review the eligibility requirements detailed in the *Application for LCIP Certification through Training*.

Observation Process

After submission of this Application for LCIP Certification through Observation:

- If the applicant is invited to be faculty at an upcoming Lions International-directed institute, he or she will be observed for certification during the institute.
- If the applicant is not invited to be faculty at an upcoming Lions International-directed institute, the applicant can request the LCIP Video Recording Request Form to provide the details of the training event he or she wants to record and submit for observation. The LCIP Video Recording Request Form needs to be submitted 2 months prior to the associated training event. Requests to be recorded for observation will be approved or rejected approximately 2 weeks after receipt of the request, based upon Leadership Development Team's review of the request form and consideration of any staffing required to support the request.

LCIP Certification Process

Determination of an applicant's status as a Lions Certified Instructor will be based on the applicant's performance during the approved observation opportunity – be it via live observation at an approved inperson training or pre-approved recording.

Application Process

Submit the completed *Application for LCIP Certification through Observation* form **2 months before the requested observation date** in order to be considered.

The **final deadline** to request LCIP Certification through observation is **January 31, 2020**. After this date, all Lions who wish to become LCIP certified will need to attend an in-person LCIP training event.

 Club Officer Trainings, Zone Chairperson Trainings, Regional Lions Leadership Institutes, First and
 Second Vice District Governor Trainings, Emerging Lions Leadership Institutes, Advanced Lions
 Leadership Institutes, Faculty Development Institutes, Lions Certified Instructor Program offerings,
 and additional programs as requested.
- 2. Seek opportunity and promote one's availability and willingness to deliver trainings at all levels, including all listed above.
- 3. In collaboration with the Global Action Team Global Leadership Team, provide regular updates to the Leadership Development Division on the status of trainings and training-related needs in your area.

- LCIP is a highly selective program. Neither approval to be observed, nor observation of an applicant guarantees certification.
- Certification, if earned, will be valid for three years; after that time, candidates may apply for recertification.
- Effective July 2020, LCIP certification will be required to serve as faculty for Lions Clubs International-directed institutes and to serve as FVDG/DGE Seminar Group Leader.
