Gifts of Securities to Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF)

Gifts of Securities that are held as book entry can easily be transferred to LCIF via wire transfer. Book entry means the donor does not hold actual security certificates but rather has a receipt indicating ownership of the security.

The donor should complete the attached form and send it to his/her brokerage firm in order to initiate the wire transfer process.
