Applications are subject to Specialty Clubs Program funds availability within a fiscal year. Specialty Club Program coordinator applications must be submitted to and received by LCI before September 30, 2019. Lions actively serving as district governors are ineligible to serve simultaneously as specialty clubs coordinator per a Board of Directors decision made at the June, 2018 meetings. <p>Charter Application Deadline - Complete charter applications received by the International Headquarters at Oak Brook, Illinois, USA, on or before the close of business on June 20th will be processed for the current fiscal year.
