- Saving sight through 9.7 million cataract surgeries
- Empowering youth in more than 110 countries through Lions Quest, a social and emotional learning program
- Providing hope through US \$140 million in disaster relief grants
- Combating measles through immunizing more than 100 million children

LCIF remains committed to magnifying YOUR service while strengthening our humanitarian mission by supporting our global causes including vision, youth, disaster relief, humanitarian efforts, diabetes, childhood cancer, hunger, and environment. We are also scaling up our service and impact by offering innovative new opportunities to empower Lions service.
