- Provides support to districts to foster positive membership growth in clubs, increase Lions visibility in the community through impactful service, build strong and innovative leaders in the districts, and increase donations to LCIF.
- Leads by example to achieve positive net membership growth as defined by *MISSION 1.5* including sponsoring at least one new member and extending at least one club.

GAT Ambassadors Responsibilities

- Participates in Global Action Team meetings and events at their own area leadership forums.
- Provides feedback to the executive officers and LCI after visits about the impact of Global Action Team, including successes, challenges or support needs.
- Motivates all Lions to take action and to utilize Global Action Team and *MISSION 1.5* resources.



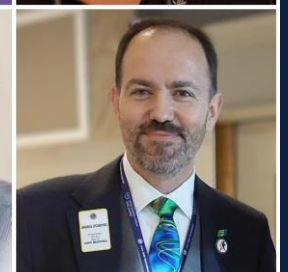
